## instructions:

Air-fill two 5" latex balloons fully and tie the necks together so that the knot is at the rolled edge of the neck to form a duplet. Tying the balloons in this manner will allow for more stretch later. Inflate four more duplets (for a total of 5 duplets). Set these aside.

Using the Mini Cool Aire® Dual Pro™ on the low setting, inflate two 27" foil tapers and tie together, as close to the necks as possible. Repeat to create a second pair of foil tapers. Twist the two pairs together, making sure to lock them in place.

Create six more taper pairs and wrap them in, one at a time, keeping all pairs together at the center point. Add the latex duplets, one at a time, to form the complete shape.

Tie monofilament around the center to secure, and measure out a length of monofilament before cutting off the spool in order to hang from the ceiling. Using the Clik-Clik™ MagPole system, the taper burst can be hung with ease!

NOTE: Add more foil tapers and latex balloons to achieve any desired look.
