

Instructions for Qualatex® Microfoil® Frond Palm Tree

(with Traditional Garland Trunk)

Labor: About 30 Minutes

Helium: About 5.4 cu. ft. (.153m³)

Materials:

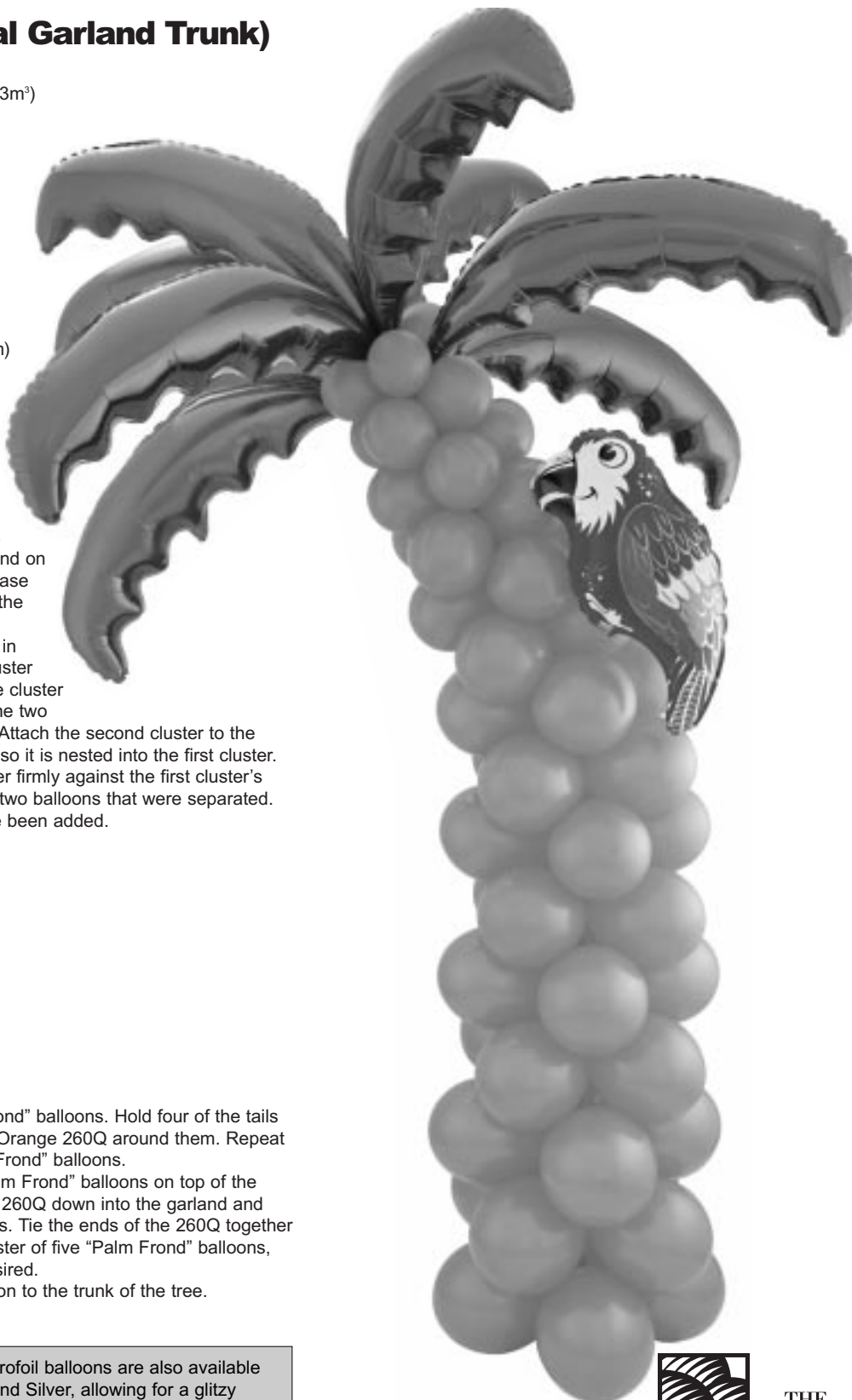
- 9 36" (91cm) "Palm Frond"
Emerald Green Microfoil
Balloons 2090-36
- 1 30" (76cm) "Parrot"
Microfoil Balloon 2327-26
- 60 11" Orange Latex Balloons
Q1125
- 2 260Q Orange Latex Balloons
Q26025
- 1 7½" (2.3m) Piece of ½" (1.3cm)
Conduit & Base Plate
- Cool Glue

Instructions:

- 1.** Bend the conduit to create the Palm Tree's curve, then attach it to the base plate.
- 2.** Air inflate 4-balloon clusters as listed below to build a garland on the conduit, beginning at the base plate. To build garland, attach the first cluster to the conduit by separating two of the balloons in the cluster and pushing the cluster onto the conduit. To secure the cluster to the conduit, twist together the two balloons that were separated. Attach the second cluster to the conduit, rotating it 45 degrees so it is nested into the first cluster. Before securing, push its center firmly against the first cluster's center, then twist together the two balloons that were separated. Continue until all clusters have been added.

Cluster #	Size
1	10" (25cm)
2, 3	9½" (24cm)
4, 5	9" (23cm)
6, 7	8½" (22cm)
8, 9	8" (20cm)
10	7½" (19cm)
11	7" (18cm)
12	6½" (17cm)
13	6" (15cm)
14	5½" (14cm)
15	5" (13cm)

- 3.** Helium inflate the "Palm Frond" balloons. Hold four of the tails together and tie an uninflated Orange 260Q around them. Repeat with the remaining five "Palm Frond" balloons.
- 4.** Place the group of four "Palm Frond" balloons on top of the "trunk," pulling the ends of the 260Q down into the garland and wrapping it through the clusters. Tie the ends of the 260Q together to secure. Repeat with the cluster of five "Palm Frond" balloons, then arrange the fronds as desired.
- 5.** Cool glue the "Parrot" balloon to the trunk of the tree.



TIP

"Palm Frond" Microfoil balloons are also available in Metallic Gold and Silver, allowing for a glitzy or fantasy look when combined with different colors of latex balloons in the trunk. Suggest different combinations to customize palm trees for your customers!
