

Happy Birthday Centerpiece

ingredients needed:



equipment:



Pre-book this balloon + pot cover for shipment late Summer 2009.

directions:

Curl the 260Q balloon gently. To do this, wrap the balloon around your fingers twice. Inflate with the Twist-N-Flate[™] so the balloons is curled only at one end. Gently let a little air out of the balloon before tying. This will enable you to manipulate the balloon without popping it. Wrap the curled end of the balloon inside the container. Secure with the Glue Dots[®].

Air-fill the 9" foil balloon with a Mini Cool Aire[®] Pro Inflator. Heat seal the balloon. Tie the stem of the balloon directly to the end of the 260Q balloon. Make a pinch twist in the 260Q balloon to make the 9" balloon stand straight.

Air-fill a 5" Quartz Purple balloon very full. Let the air out of the balloon until it is very small. Manipulate the air inside the balloon and twist in the middle. Repeat this step and wrap together to form a 4-balloon cluster. Wrap around the foil balloon and the 260Q balloon to make a collar for the 9" balloon.

Air-fill a 5" Quartz Purple balloon to 5 inches. Insert to balloon inside the curl of the entertainer balloon. Secure with Glue Dots. Project completed!
