directions:

Helium inflate (3)18" Happy Birthday Foil balloons. Tie on ribbons and set aside. Air fill a 260Q balloon with a battery operated Twist-N-Flate™. Tie off the end and place into the bag. Repeat using random colors and lengths. Don't be too concerned about making the balloons all the same size.

Work the balloons into the bag and manipulate them to create gentle curves. Tie off the stingers and clip off the excess.

Attach a handful of shred to the end of each balloon. Use a stick to transfer the glue from the glue pan to the balloon. Use a low setting on the glue pan. The thicker the glue the better.

Stuff shred into the bag to fill the space between the balloons.

Use double-sided sticky tape to hide the stem of a flat 18" foil balloon by folding it over on to itself. Center the bag on the flat 18" foil to add an additional splash of color. Finish off the design by adding the helium-inflated 18" balloons. Be sure to tie the ribbon and attach the weight before inflating. Don't worry about the color or style of the balloon weight as it will be hidden inside the bag.
