Baby Girl Bubbles[™]

ingredients needed:



255226 22" Bubbles™ Baby Girl Balloon



160Q Latex

Plush

Ribbon



CW6212 Cello Dots Sheets

equipment:

Heavy Weights[™]

829 Twist-N-Flate[™] Inflator



BR74HG Dual Foil + Latex Regulator



directions:

Helium inflate the baby Bubbles™ balloon with the latex tip on the regulator. Be sure to inflate until all wrinkles disappear. This balloon will appear very round in shape. Clip the curling ribbon off the balloon and add the polka dot ribbon. Attach the ribbon directly to the loop on the weight.

Roll out the cello paper and cut several 6 inch strips. Turn the paper and cut into desired lengths. This will give you cello tufts. Take 2 cello tufts and turn them in opposite directions. Tie the cello tufts tightly in the middle with ribbon. Tie this directly to the loop on the Heavy Weight[™].

Inflate a 160Q entertainer balloon with the Twist-N-Flate™. Do not fill the balloon completely full. Let a little air out of the neck of the balloon to ensure the balloon will twist without breaking. This is called "burping the balloon." Tie the knot end to the un-inflated end. To make a figure eight, find the center of the balloon and push it into the knotted end. Twist and lock into place. Repeat this step with 3 more 160Q balloons. Stack all 4 balloons together and twist. Attach directly to the stem of the bubble balloon.

Repeat the figure eight step above with two yellow 160Q balloons. Twist the balloons one more time to create 4 loops on each balloon. Twist together and secure to the ribbon at the bottom of the arrangement.
