

MagicArch Balloons

MagicArch is a modular balloon system that allows you to easily create columns, wall decorations and centerpieces. The cloverleaf design of the balloon allows the user to fill four perfectly uniform in size balloons all at once.

Advantages of using this system:

- Balloons stay inflated much longer than latex balloons.
- It saves time.
- It expands decorating options.

To determine the number of balloon units needed to build an arch or column:

1. Convert the measurement in feet to inches by multiplying 12" x the number of feet.
2. Divide the height of the column or the length of the arch by the thickness of the inflated unit.

Example: For a 30 ft. arch
 $30' \times 12'' = 360''$
 $360'' \text{ divided by } 7.8'' = 46 \text{ units}$

Please note:

Small units inflate to 16" x 3.875". The small unit should only be filled with air.

Large units inflate to 29.5" x 7.8". The large unit can be filled with air or helium.

MagicArch Balloon Arch Recipe

Ingredients:

Ribbon or string cut to desired arch length plus 2' extra
Weights for arch (example: bricks)
MagicArch balloons
Helium

Tie one end of the ribbon to a weight or tape ribbon with wide tape to the floor. Inflate the balloon. Thread the ribbon through the center of the balloon. Repeat steps 2 and 3. The arch forms automatically.

Important: Be sure to use only thin nylon cord, ribbon or string with MagicArch balloons. Do not use monofilament line.
